Alliance Spacesystems, LLC has an immediate need for a 5 Axis CNC Machinist. A 40-hour workweek is standard but at times additional hours may be required to fulfill duties and responsibilities to meet customer requirements.

Job Summary:

The 5 Axis CNC Machinist is responsible for set-up, operation, and programming of machine with minimal supervision of tasks on a daily basis. Preferred candidate will also be able to set-up, operate and program 3 Axis CNC routing and milling machines. Candidate should be able to machine composite and metallic structures/details, as well as interpret blueprints, sketches, and engineer specifications.

Essential Job Functions:

Under the directions of the Machine Shop Supervisor, the CNC Machinist must be able to machine semi-complex, prototype and production hardware.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Determine sequence of operations by studying blueprints, CAD models, specifications, and work orders.
- Operates computing equipment to access job information (e.g., drawings, specifications and other online information systems) and perform job tasks (e.g., upload/download programs, create/edit CNC programs).
- Prepare machine for production by positioning and securing stops, guides, and turntables.
- Perform proper setup and tool calibration procedures for 5 Axis equipment.
- Able to design and construct milling fixtures to secure and machine hardware.
- Regulate machining by setting and adjusting controls.
- Produce parts by locating and marking reference points on work piece with rule, template, etc.; positioning or aligning work piece against stops and guides.
- Maintain specifications by observing operations; detecting malfunctions; inspecting parts; adjusting controls.
- Resolve production problems by altering process to meet specifications; notifying supervisor/program manager to obtain additional resources.
- Ensure operation of equipment by completing preventive maintenance requirements; following manufacturer's instructions; troubleshooting malfunctions; notifying supervision for repairs.
- Maintain tool inventory by checking stock to determine amount available; anticipating needed tools; placing and expediting orders for tools; verifying receipt of tools.
- Maintains the work area and equipment in a clean orderly condition and follows prescribed safety regulations.
- Performs but not limited to the following tasks: milling, drilling, tapping, de-burring, and all bench operations.

Duties and responsibilities may be added, deleted, modified or changed at any time at the Company's discretion. Changes may be made formally, informally either verbally or in writing.



Education/Experience/ Training:

High School GED and/or minimum of eight years' experience in related field.

- 5+ years related experience in an aerospace composites industry (or related field)
- Able to independently program and operate 5 Axis Machine required
- Must have the ability to run all machinery i.e. Mills, Lathes, Band saws, etc.
- Ability to program using Mater Cam X 15 or later required.
- Sinumerik 840D (Siemens Controller) highly preferred.
- Able to run a variety of 3 Axis CNC routers and mills preferred.
- Ability to run conventional machinery i.3. Mills, Lathes, Band saws, etc. preferred.
- Experience machining composites and metallic required

Physical Requirements:

Ability to safely stand or sit for 95% of the working shift.

Be able to carry 50 lbs. for a distance of 25 feet.

Ability to read, write and converse in the English language.

Able Stretch and bend over large working areas and tables.

Occasional use of Hearing protection required

Regular use of safety glasses required

Work Schedule:
